ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-2020

The college has witnessed several developmental activities throughout the period.

- A total number of 1183 students were admitted for all disciplines.
- Scholarship amount of Rs 11913838- had been given to 333 meritorious students in this year.
- We have conducted 19 add-on courses for the enhancement of the student knowledge in which 703 students had participated. This enabled the students and faculty members to enrich their subject competency and expertise in their desired discipline and for the growth of the institution.
- This year due to the Covid-19 pandemic, online classes were conducted from March 2020. We have uploaded teaching materials on an online platform and online tests were conducted on a weekly basis and the progress of the student was informed to the parents systematically through the tutors. Parents and the stakeholders very much appreciated our systematic approach in the execution of online classes.
- 9 MOU's/ Collaborations were established during the 2019-2020 academic year.
- Gurudeepam software is used for effective monitoring of lesson planning, syllabus coverage, student's attendance etc.
- Mentoring systems play a vital role in grooming the students. Every mentor will have 30 students and they constantly facilitate and guide them to become successful. Two advisors are assigned for each class.
- In order to see the progress in the performance of the students we organize class committee and course committee meetings thrice in a semester.
- Students are encouraged to enroll in certification courses such as NPTEL, COURSERA etc. They are also encouraged to participate in seminars, symposiums, workshops etc.
- 698 students were effectively gone for internships and done innovative projects as part of their curriculum.
- A total of 27 Value added programs were offered by various departments and 682 students were benefitted of these programs.
- Faculty members are encouraged to pursue Doctoral Degree and article publications in reputed journals.
- 20 research publications were contributed by the faculty members during the 2019-20 academic year.
- Faculty members were encouraged to attend various faculty development Programmes, seminars, conferences, and workshops during this academic year and 101 faculty members were financially supported by SNGCE.



- Students participated in about 35 sports and cultural events.
- Placement training sessions are conducted by the placement cell.
- Total number of students who appeared in the final semester examination were 415MBA to be and 310students cleared the examination.
- Total 242 students have been placed in various companies during this academic year
- 8 faculty members have completed their Ph.Dprogrammes during the academic Year 2019-20. 2 faculty members have joined for their Ph.Dprogramme under different universities during the current academic year .
- SNGCE organized "PONNONAM-2019" on 6/7/2019.
- SNGCE Celebrated Kerala Piravi Day on 01 November.
- ARANGU'19 the arts fest was organized.
- SNGCE Organized an induction programme for first year B.Tech (2019-2023 Batch) students
- SNGCE Organized Alumni Interaction online and made it a successful reunion of students.
- Students of NSS unit organized Teachers Day celebrations on 5th of September 2019. The day was celebrated by gifting teachers a pen as the token of their love and respect.
- NSS volunteers were involved in Flood Relief Activities, Food, grains and washing items were packed and distributed to flood affected areas in Wayanad, Perumbavoor, Nilambur etc.
- The Department of Civil Engineering was a part of The REBUILD KERALA Initiative by the Local Self Government Department, to reinstate the damaged roads due to flooding in the locality.
- NSS Blood Donation Camp was organized in SNGCE campus and it was a great success with more than 35 students donating blood.
- NSS unit of SNGCE conducted a session on awareness on ORGANIC FARMING. The event was inaugurated by Panchayath member ward No: 432 and class was taken by Dr. Haridas.
- A total of 25 outreach activities were conducted by SNGCE in 2019-2020.



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
