ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-2022

The academic year 2021-2022 witnessed a significant shift as colleges transitioned from online to offline modes of education following the pandemic-induced disruptions. This annual report provides a gist of the academic and related activities held during the academic year 2021-2022.

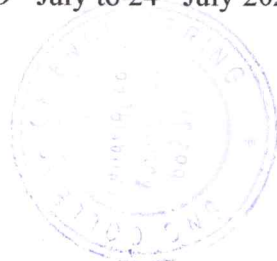
- During the academic year 2021-2022, a total of 379 students were admitted to various disciplines. These students participated in an extensive induction and orientation program, which spanned over a period of 5 days. Notably, separate orientation programs were organized specifically for students pursuing MBA, MCA, and Btech programs.
- In the academic year, the college took significant steps towards empowering deserving students by providing scholarships. A generous amount of Rs 17016950 was allocated for scholarships, reflecting the college's commitment to supporting academic excellence.
- The various departments conducted 56 add on courses for the enhancement of the student knowledge in which 1063 students had participated. These courses offer the opportunity to acquire additional skills and knowledge beyond one's primary field of study or expertise and can help individuals develop specialized skills that can complement their existing qualifications and make them more versatile in the job market.
- Certification courses offer valuable opportunities for students to enhance their skills, expand their knowledge, and gain industry-recognized credentials. Students are encouraged to enroll in certification courses such as NPTEL, COURSERA etc.
- Internships provide numerous benefits for students, offering valuable experiences and opportunities to kick start their careers. As part of their curriculum, 260 students from various departments completed internship programs.
- During each semester, class committee and course committee meetings are conducted to monitor the progress of the students.
- A total of 226 students participated in the final semester examination, out of which 127 students successfully cleared the examination.



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- 8 faculty members have completed their Ph.D programmes during the academic Year 2022-23. 11 faculty members have joined for their Ph.D programme during the current academic year.
- Faculty members were encouraged to attend various faculty development Programmes, seminars, conferences, and workshops during this academic year and 66 faculty members were financially supported by SNGCE.
- Total 81 Faculty development programs have been attended by faculty members of various departments in this academic year.
- 5 Faculty members from the Civil Engineering Department cleared Kerala PSC Examination; Ms. Karthika Ramesan, Ms. Anila P V, Ms. Salini P S, Ms. Namitha N, and Ms. Rekha Raveendran.
- Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development centre of SNGCE organized “IDEATHON 2021” on 30th November 2021 to encourage innovation among students.
- SNGCE organized a 3 day workshop on Data Visualization using Power BI from 22nd to 24th March 2022.
- The Department of Computer Applications has organized a Tech Fest titled as “Prayaan” on 5th April 2022.
- The placement cell of SNGCE conducts training sessions on a regular basis.
- In the Academic year 149 Students placed and received 223 offers from various companies.
- The college celebrates Onam and Christmas in colourful mode.
- SNGCE Organized TechFest “Fugeniz9”- a venue for showcasing technical talents of students inside and outside the campus and it was inaugurated by Mr. K K Karnan , President of SNG Trust.
- SNGCE Organized Arts Fest “Arangu ’23”- The Festival Featuring Numerous Competitions between 4 Houses of the Institution and it was inaugurated by Mr. K K Karnan , President of SNG Trust.
- Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering of Sree Narayana Gurukulam College of Engineering was sanctioned with a funded FDP on the Topic Ethics in Profession and student psychology by KTU. EEE department conducted the FDP in online mode from 19th July to 24th July 2021.



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
